## PEACE WALK

MISSION PLAZA - Memorial Day - MON, MAY 26, 11am

A silent, reflective walk for peace – in our hearts, in our community, in our nation, in Iraq and in the world.

Memorials honoring Iraqi civilians and U.S./Coalition forces who have died will be on display at Mission Plaza in Santa Cruz.

Join us in silent solidarity for peace. After a brief time of welcome and reflection, we'll walk together for about an hour, past the river and along Pacific Avenue sidewalks through downtown...returning to Mission Plaza for a short closing ceremony. Bring flowers instead of slogan signs. Group-identifying signs/banners are welcome, as are peace flags, earth flags, etc. Dress in black and/or white if possible (not required).

Remember water, hat, sunscreen.

Where: Gather at the fountain at Mission Plaza, near Holy Cross Church.

**Who:** People of all beliefs, cultures and ages who wish to strengthen inner peace and contribute to creating a more peaceful world.

Why: In this time of war, conflict and division, we say to our nation's leaders that war is not the answer. The way to peace is through cultivating compassion in our own hearts, in our actions, and in the world.
