Dear Friend,

Would you please take a moment to check the enclosed "Party Affiliation Voter Registration Card" and return it to the RNC's Headquarters in Washington, D.C. today?

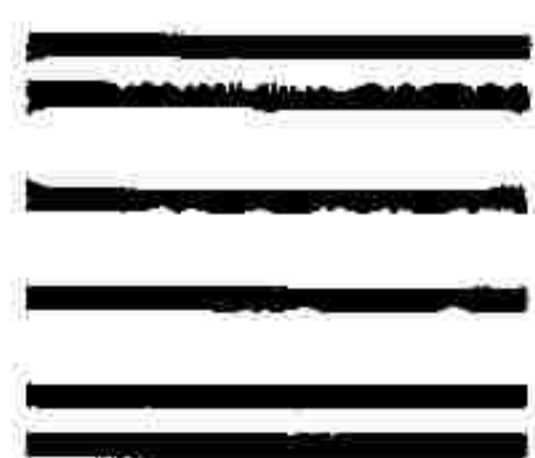
